COMMUNIQUÉ

The Waiving of Penalty under the Arrears Payment Scheme (APS) will end on 31 May 2018

The Public is kindly informed that in the Budget 2017/2018, the Government has provided for a Scheme to alleviate the settlement of any outstanding debts resulting from the reassessment of property under the Arrears Payment Scheme (APS) 2017. This Scheme provides for the waiving of penalty where the duty or tax has remained unpaid as at 08 June 2017 on the conditions that:

- (i) the duty and taxes are paid not later than 31 May 2018; and*
- (ii) in relation to the payment of duty and taxes at the time of payment, the person withdraws*
 - any objection before the Registrar-General,*
 - any representations before the Assessment Review Committee set up under the Mauritius Revenue Authority;*
 - any appeal before the Supreme Court or Judicial Committee of the Privy Council.*

Please note that any payment received after 31 May 2018 will include the penalty.
